- Al Discussion: We discussed options for how to best approach the use of AI in the NHERI REU application. A suggestion of a drop-down menu for each essay question was suggested, but most felt that having instructions at the beginning of the application that indicate AI should not be used to generate your answers on your application. Discussion also includes whether we should check each application for use of AI and if we have the bandwidth to do so.
- Social Science Discussion: Even though CONVERGE will not be supporting REU students this summer, the ECO decided to keep all social science questions within the NHERI REU application, and several sites hope to continue to support interdisciplinary research and social science participants.
- The goal is to have the NHERI REU application approved by the September ECO meeting and launch it no later than October 1, 2024, and the NSF ETAP application by October 7, 2024.
